The Miracle of NaProTECHNOLOGY



I remember like it was yesterday, anxiously sitting in the waiting room of the Culture of Life Family Services. I had just found out that I was pregnant with our first child, and I had been experiencing some spotting.

My eyes welled up with tears as I saw the gestational sac on the ultrasound screen that was measuring 5 weeks when I was supposed to be 8 weeks. I was miscarrying and full of sorrow. I didn't understand what was happening. I received a call from COLFS. The lab work came back confirming the miscarriage, and I was told that I had unusually low levels of progesterone.

Several months later, I was ecstatic when I found out I was pregnant again. I called COLFS right away to get

an order to have my hormones checked. I received a call asking me to come into the office. At this point, I was 5 weeks pregnant. Dr. Saroki explained to me NaProTECHNOLOGY. She told me that my progesterone hormone was low again and she wanted to prevent another miscarriage. For the next 30 weeks, I went to the office two times a week to receive progesterone shots. We were overjoyed when finally in February 2011, I delivered our first child, Xavier Jude.

NaProTECHNOLOGY and COLFS are so integrated in our lives, our story doesn't end there. My husband and I experienced some infertility as we tried to have another child. I again needed progesterone injections to maintain the pregnancy. But in 2014, we welcomed our precious daughter, Avila Rose. Conception the third time around was easy compared to all that we had been through. I was able to stop the progesterone after the first trimester with our third child. We welcomed our beautiful daughter, Siena Marie, in the summer of 2016.

We hope the Lord will bless us with more children in our future, and I know that COLFS will likely be part of their story as well. We are forever indebted to Culture of Life Family Services and Drs. Delgado and Saroki. If it was not for them, for NaProTECHNOLOGY and for their research, I truly believe I would not have any of my children here with me today.

At last year's 2017 Culture of Life Family Services (COLFS) annual Gala, our family—along with three other families— won the football camp that Philip and Tiffany Rivers donated to the event. We were also delighted that the Rivers family was able to join us for the camp; while the boys were playing football, all the other children got to play with each other on the playground, prompting Makayla, age 13, to comment, "Philip Rivers has the nicest family."

Philip taught the children how to move around in the pocket and how to hold the ball after the snap. The practice ended with all the boys getting pictures with Philip, as well as signed memorabilia. The memories will be more precious to them as they look back on all the fun they had.

The highlight of the day was when we all shared lunch together, and Philip led the group of families in prayer before the meal. Since our group was mostly Chaldean, we also included the Our Father in Aramaic, bringing our faith alive amidst the camaraderie of our fellowship with all the families. COLFS was represented by Dr. George and Liz Delgado.

The football camp was a great event for our families and brought joy to all of us who attended. We're so grateful to the Rivers family for generously donating their time to COLFS, allowing these children to have such a memorable experience and hang out with a great role model. Lucas, age 8, summed it up for everyone there: "Just seeing Philip Rivers was great enough."

In addition, the Confirmation students took a tour of the Women's Mobile Clinic ultrasound unit parked outside of the parish hall and heard a powerful testimony by COLFS volunteer and Silent No More representative, Carol Marie Siedenburg.

St. Timothy Church of Escondido recently held a similar event for their Confirmation students. I encourage others to do the same.
